Marine Cable Installation **Starting July 27th through the end of August 2022.**

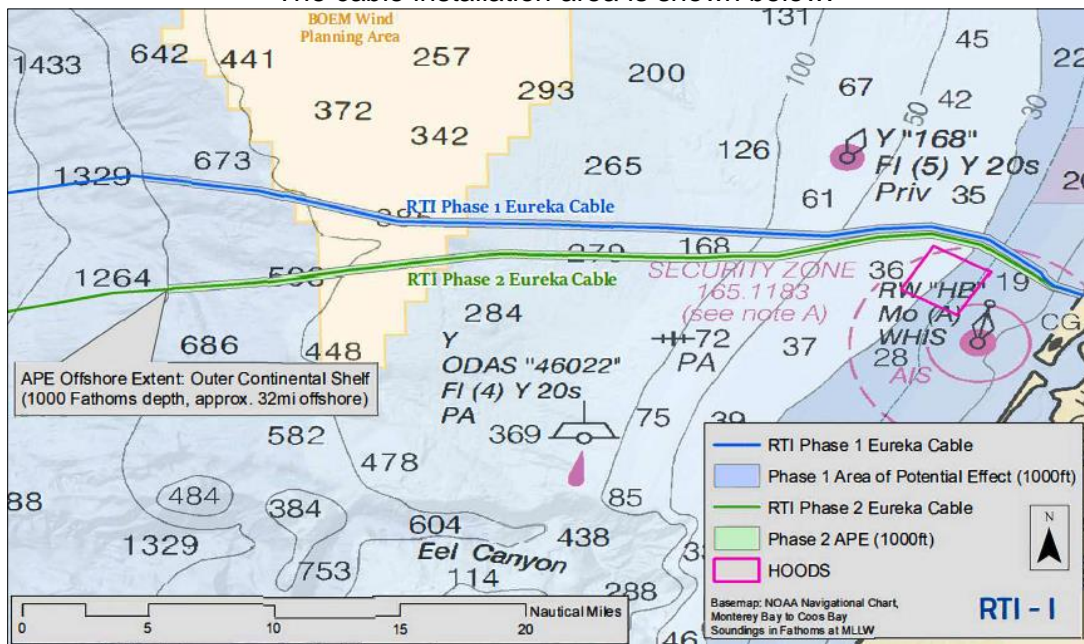
Installation operations for the RTI-I Subsea Cables is under way. The operations are planned to recommence on **July 27 and continue until August 28, 2022.**

Installation operations will be conducted by the 379' Cable Ship Segero and an attending support vessel equipped with ROV, the 266' M/V Clean Ocean. A local guard boat has been engaged to assist in on-water communications during the cable installation process.

Fishermen and mariners are requested to maintain safe operating distance of at least 2 nautical miles from the installation vessels which will be operating under restricted maneuverability. The planned Eureka fiber optic cables will link northern California's internet, telephone communications and other data to the global communications network.
