Chair Leroy Zerlang called the meeting to order at 0900 hours.

- 1. Committee and Meeting Attendee Introductions were made. Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call. Comments by Chairperson: None.
- 2. Public Comment: None.
- 3. Consent Calendar:
  - a. Approve Meeting Minutes from March 21, 2024, May 16, 2024, and July 18, 2024:

- 4. USCG Reports:
  - a. Nuisance Vessels / Unseaworthy Vessels / Sunken Vessels / Abandoned Vehicles / Vessels / Debris Abatement / Oil Spills / Accidents / Incidents: Scott Miller gave report.
- 5. US Army Corps of Engineers Report: Amber Shehan gave report on behalf of Peter Mull. Next Dredge cycle will be the Essayons in late May. West Coast Hopper will include Bar & Entrance in the contract, tentatively scheduled for June, pending contract and contractor. Background NEPA for Near Shore/Open Water placement continues, hope to implement in 2025 next to North Spit as an alternative site for dredging disposal. The Harbor District has expressed interest in Pump to Shore Beach nourishment, will need funding to begin permitting.

## 6. Port/ Harbor/ Marina Reports:

- a. Trinidad Harbor: None.
- b. City of Eureka Marina: None.
- c. Port of Humboldt Bay: Chris Mikkelsen gave report. Recent storm damage to the Peninsula is an example of local need for pump-to-shore, Beneficial Beach Reuse of dredge materials. VW Trust fund has new funding opportunities including drayage equipment like the travel lift. Chris has a request from the West Coast Safety Council to coordinate record keeping of ship traffic within Humboldt Bay in a central database with upcoming large capital projects, and to track fuel.
- 7. OSPR Reports: Reuben Macaspac gave report. Heather Geldart is the new OSPR Administrator, replacing Julie Yamamoto who will remain as Deputy Administrator.

- d. Bar Pilots: John Powell gave report the Ocean Pegasus departed on 09/13/2024.
- e. Tank Barge: Ross McDonald had nothing to report.
- f. Dry Cargo: Colin Campbell gave report, expecting ship in mid-October.
- **g. Tug Operators:** Leroy Zerlang gave an update, no changes to current tug status. Ross McDonald reported the Koos King will leave in October for the remainder of 2024 to be repowered. Nick Preston reported the Renegade will be replacing the Koos King while it is being repowered.

- i. **Commercial Fishing**: Leroy Zerlang gave report albacore season poor, price down for Black cod. Triple Star is back, Pacific Seafoods not buying fish.
- **j.** Recreational Boater Safety: Kent Hulbert gave report, albacore season poor, not in area. Asked for enforcement of No-Wake zone. Bridget Hand-Nichols gave a report, summer season wrapped up. Enrollment patchy, hours adjusted for tides, weekend operations continue. Dock replaced at aquatic center.

  - a. Buoy 9 & 10: Scott Miller gave report. The Cutter Alder is scheduled for mid-October to repair Buoys 9 & 10 before crab season.

- a. Attendance of Meetings: Amber Shehan presented slides encouraging attendance and participation in meetings.
- b. No-wake enforcement signage: The committee held an informal discussion regarding increasing signage for no-wake to educate boaters. The municipal code only covers the Inner reach and in between islands. Hog Island, Fairhaven Terminal, Schneider Dock, and the dredging contractors have requested a No-Wake zone. Chris Mikkelsen suggested there may be grants available for potential signage. Possible outreach in Spring 2025. Harbor District to research and review options.

a. Harbor Safety Plan – Chapter Assignment Review: Amber Shehan presented the Chapter Assignments and timeline for edits to the FY 24/25 Harbor Safety Plan.
