## Humboldt Bay Navigational Aids out of position

The Coast Guard has temporarily relocated Aids to Navigation HUMBOLDT BAY LB 9 (LLNR 8195) and HUMBOLDT BAY LB 10 (LLNR 8200) to facilitate dredging operations through the months of September, October and possibly into November 2020, by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

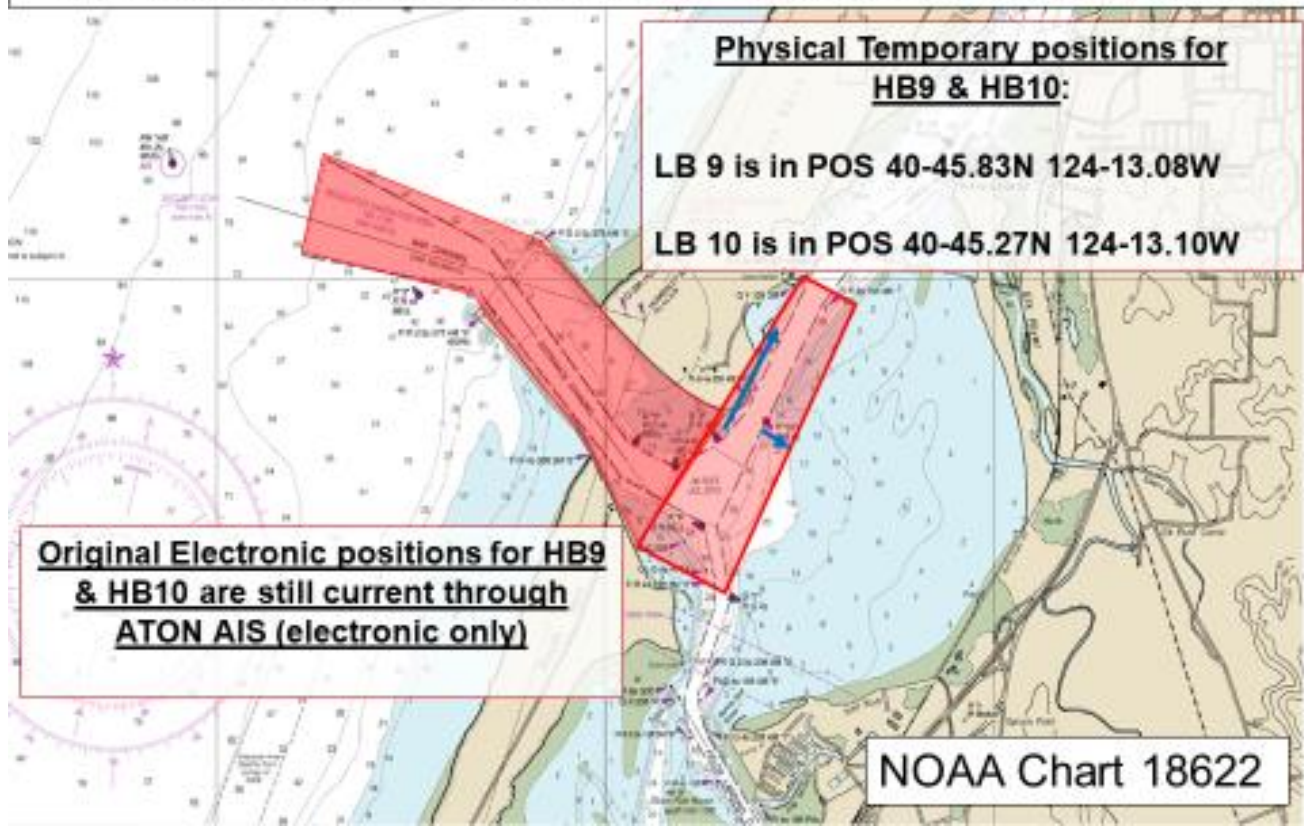
HUMBOLDT BAY LB 9 is now established in position 40-45.83N 124-13.08W

HUMBOLDT BAY LB 10 is now established in position 40-45.27N 124-13.10W

Electronic AIS positions for these aids remain in their original published NOAA chart positions to assist mariners in avoiding these shoal areas.

Safety updates will continue to be announced via Broadcast Notice to Mariners VHF-FM channel 16, and published through the local Notice To All Mariners (NOTAM). Any vessel needing assistance, or updates, shall contact Sector Humboldt Bay on VHF-FM channel 16 or at (707) 839-6113.
